




### a) Single Child & Siblings:

» 142 students have siblings, and 33 students do not have siblings, meaning they are the only child in their family.


#### b) Single Parent/Guardian and Both Parents:

- » 131 students have both parents.


#### c) Family Income Distribution:

- » Only 1 student belongs to a well-off family with an income of ₹4,00,000 & above.


#### d) Parents' Occupation Distribution:

#### e) Gender Distribution of Students:





» Science Stream: 88 students » Commerce Stream: 43 students » Arts St



» Out of 19 students, 5 are in primary school, while the remaining 14 are in higher secondary education,8 in the science stream and 6 in the commerce stream.


#### b) Institute Type of Enrolled Students:

- » **57 students** are **compassionate** category, highlights the program's role in aiding those in need due to specific circumstances.



#### b) Urban & Rural Background of Students:




**Analysis:** The data represents the **areas of the 175 students**. The breakdown is given below:

#### **Financial Assistance Provided:**


#### a) Types of Assistance Provided:

- » 3 students received support for hostel fees.
- » 6 students received assistance for laptop, while 1 student received support for both laptop & PG (accommodation) fees. Additionally, 1 student received assistance for laptop and college transportation.
- » 10 students received support for mess fees, while 6 students received assistance for PG (accommodation) fees.


#### b) Support Frequency Semesterly & Yearly:

#### c) Assistance Provided Based on Course Details:




**Analysis:** The data represents the **assistance provided for various courses** pursued by **175 students**. The breakdown is as follows:

- » 1 student is pursuing an LLB degree, while 1 student appeared for a competitive examination at the Bar Council of Gujarat.
- » 1 student is pursuing a diploma, and 1 student is enrolled in a certified course.
- » 2 students are pursuing a B.Ed., 1 student is enrolled in B.Sc. B.Ed., 6 students are pursuing a BCA & 1 student is pursuing an M.A.

**Analysis:** The data presents the total funds disbursed for various educational programs. Below is the breakdown:



**Analysis:** The data represents the number of applications rejected and selected month-wise from April 2024 to March 2025.

- » The **highest** number of applications were **rejected** in **December**, while the **lowest** number of **rejections occurred** in August.
- » The **highest** number of applications were **selected** in **August**, whereas the **lowest** selections were recorded in **September, October, and March 2025.**

- » Renewal Documentation Finalization: Key documents, including Renewal Proposals and Understanding Notes, were finalized and successfully implemented to support ongoing beneficiary engagement.

#### **Process Improvements**

» Streamlined Financial and Renewal Workflows: Enhanced the payment process to ensure secure, structured transactions and initiated efforts to simplify and formalize the beneficiary renewal process, currently in progress.

#### **MIS Development**

» System Upgrades and Integration: Periodic enhancements to the Management Information System (MIS) improved overall data management and operational efficiency. A dedicated module was also developed to monitor student renewals and track critical beneficiary information.

#### iv. Navigating the Storm

#### a) Challenges Faced

#### **Internal Process Challenges**

- » Language barriers and regional language documents complicate communication and verification, adding to the complexity of extensive document checks and data entry during onboarding.
- » Limited manpower strains the management of documentation and MIS, especially during peak application periods.
- » Renewal is at an early stage, making the process definition and streamlining an ongoing challenge.
- » Obtaining accurate data is difficult due to frequent submission of incorrect or invalid documents.

#### **External Process Challenges**

- » Securing payment letters from applicants' colleges post-approval is often problematic, sometimes resulting in rejection.
- » Prolonged processing times arise from repeated follow-ups for documents and testimonials.
- » Applicant unresponsiveness hampers timely communication and delays application progress.

#### b) Strategic Pathways Ahead:

#### **Documentation**

» Finalize the Standard Operating Procedures (SOP) for both onboarding and renewal processes, and develop a comprehensive tracking sheet for month-wise fund disbursements to enable consistent reconciliation with the Finance Department.

#### **Process**

- » Establish a streamlined end-to-end application handling process with a monthly target of onboarding 30 students to ensure steady growth and operational efficiency.
- » Develop standardized communication tools including a payment authorization letter and WhatsApp message templates for follow-ups, testimonials, payment receipts, and document requests.
- » Implement task management using calendar reminders to ensure timely follow-ups and program oversight.
- » Revise the Understanding document to include mentor program details and draft a congratulatory email to enhance student engagement.
- » Define clear criteria for adjusting assistance amounts and evaluating one-time assistance applicants.
- » Complete the renewal process for 150 candidates to ensure continuity of support.

#### Management Information System (MIS)

» Implement a stage-wise enhancement of the MIS to optimize data management and operational efficiency, with regular updates to adapt to emerging challenges and support seamless workflows.

# Medical Course bifurcation w.r.t. count of students




# iv. Mentor and Mentee Experiences


